D, §35, is 14 further amended to read: 15 16 1. Requirements. Notwithstanding section 15205-A, whenever a passenger elevator is installed in a building being newly constructed or in a new addition that extends beyond 17 18 the exterior walls of an existing building, the at least one passenger elevator must reach all 19 levels every story within the building and be of sufficient size to allow the transport of a 20 person on an ambulance stretcher in the fully supine position, without having to raise, lower 21 or bend the stretcher in any way. This requirement applies to all plans approved after 22 January 1, 2002. As used in this subsection, "story" has the same meaning as in the International Building Code, as adopted by the Technical Building Codes and Standards 23 Board under Title 10, section 9722. The director shall adopt rules necessary to carry out 24 25 the provisions of this section. Rules adopted pursuant to this section subsection are routine 26 technical rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.' 27 Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section 28 number to read consecutively. 29 **SUMMARY** 30 This amendment replaces the provisions of the bill and requires that whenever a 31 passenger elevator is installed in a building being newly constructed or in a new addition 32 that extends beyond the exterior walls of an existing building, at least one passenger 33 elevator must reach every story within the building and be of sufficient size to allow the 34 transport of a person on an ambulance stretcher in the fully supine position, without having 35 to raise, lower or bend the stretcher in any way. The amendment provides that "story" has
