I	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	<b>Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §2422-A, sub-§2, ¶A,</b> as enacted by PL 2021, c. 652, §1, is amended to read:
4 5 6 7 8	A. Notwithstanding Title 5, section 8072, subsection 11 or any other provision of law to the contrary, rules provisionally adopted by the department in accordance with this subsection and submitted for legislative review may not be finally adopted by the department unless legislation authorizing final adoption of those rules is enacted into law.
9	This paragraph is repealed on November 1, 2025.
10	SUMMARY
11 12 13 14	This bill removes the provision of law that, on November 1, 2025, repeals the requirement that major substantive rules provisionally adopted by the Department of Administrative and Financial Services relating to the Maine Medical Use of Cannabis Act and submitted for legislative review may not be finally adopted by the department unless
15	legislation authorizing final adoption of those rules is enacted into law.
