Amend the bill in section 1 in §4710-C in subsection 7 in the 2nd line (page 2, line 19 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "student information and" and inserting the following: 'curricula and professional development'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §4710-C in subsection 7 in the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 2, lines 19 and 20 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "3rd-party contractors" and inserting the following: 'the public'

Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

**'Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and allocations are made.
