30 SUMMARY

This amendment changes, from an account within the Department of Labor to an account maintained by the Permanent Commission on the Status of Racial, Indigenous and Tribal Populations, the account into which funds received by the commission must be deposited. The amendment moves the statutory allocation of the establishment of the commission from the section of law concerning advisory boards and boards with minimal authority to the section of law concerning independent advisory boards to categorize the commission as a commission that has a separate line item in the budget document and to which money is allocated or appropriated by the Legislature. The amendment also transfers unobligated balances in the Racial, Indigenous and Maine Tribal Populations, Other Special Revenue Funds account within the Permanent
