The amendment provides that the pilot program must identify dual-use projects that collectively have a total capacity of not less than 20 megawatts nor more than 60 megawatts, rather than 30 megawatts with at least 20 megawatts reserved for dual-use projects on agricultural land as proposed in the bill.

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- 1 The amendment clarifies that developers, with the informed consent of the landowner, 2 as well as landowners may apply for the pilot program.
- Finally, the amendment authorizes the department, in coordination with the Governor's
 Energy Office, to implement the pilot program.
