2	This amendment replaces the bill. It requires a hospital to post in a publicly accessible
3	area of its emergency department information provided by the Department of Health and
4	Human Services regarding how individuals with substance use disorder can access
5	evidence-based treatment services. It adds an appropriations and allocations section
6	providing \$30,000 in one-time grant funds to support substance use disorder treatments
7	that include family members of the person with substance use disorder, including
8	community reinforcement and family training interventions.
