Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

- **Sec. 1. Community school application, procedures and criteria.** By October 1, 2023, the Department of Education shall develop an application process, procedures and criteria for implementing the requirements for designation of community schools pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, chapter 333. The department shall adopt rules to implement this section. Rules adopted pursuant to this section are routine technical rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.
- **Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and allocations are made.

General Purpose Aid for Local Schools 0308

Initiative: Provides additional one-time funding for grants to public elementary and secondary schools to expand the community school program pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, chapter 333.
