1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §6001, sub-§4 is enacted to read:
3 4 5 6	4. Parent or guardian access to education records. Upon request of a parent or guardian of a juvenile who is a student, a public school or private school shall provide an education record or other record concerning that juvenile to the parent or guardian unless the juvenile is emancipated under Title 15, section 3506-A.
7	SUMMARY
8 9 10	This bill requires public and private schools, upon request, to provide education records and other records of a juvenile who is a student to the parent or guardian of that juvenile unless the juvenile is emancipated.
