1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1751, sub-§1-A is enacted to read:
3 4 5 6	<b>1-A. Exception; Class C motor vehicles.</b> Notwithstanding subsection 1, a motor vehicle that a holder of a Class C license is authorized to operate pursuant to section 1252, subsection 1, paragraph C is not required to have an inspection until 3 years from the last day of the month in which it was manufactured.

8 9 10	This bill provides that a motor vehicle that a holder of a Class C license is authorized to operate is not required to have an inspection until 3 years from the last day of the month in which it was manufactured.
