7	'Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2054, sub-§2, ¶C, as amended by PL 2019, c. 327, §1, is further amended by enacting a new subparagraph (2-A) to read:
.9 20 21 22	(2-A) A wrecker may be equipped with a flashing green auxiliary light mounted on top of the vehicle in such a manner as to emit a green light over a 360-degree angle. A flashing green auxiliary light on a wrecker equipped in accordance with this subparagraph may be used only when:
23 24	(a) The operator is assisting another vehicle operator or loading a vehicle onto the wrecker; and
25 26	(b) The wrecker is pulled to the side of, or off, a public way and has halted in a location where it can safely remain stationary.'
27 28	Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
29	SUMMARY
0	This amendment replaces the bill. The amendment:
31 32	1. Allows for a wrecker to use a flashing green light only when pulled over, assisting motorists and loading vehicles; and
33	2. Prohibits use of a flashing green light while the wrecker is moving.

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
