2 3 4 5	This amendment strikes from the bill the repeal of current law relating to temporary registration plates and the enactment of similar provisions in another section of law in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 29-A. The amendment strikes from the bill the limit on the number of active specialty license plates.
6 7	The amendment also revises provisions relating to vanity plates and Purple Hear registration plates to change the term "service fee" to "administrative fee."
