1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. P&SL 2009, c. 32, §5 is amended to read:
3 4 5 6	Sec. 5. Number of trustees. The board of trustees of the district is composed of $\frac{5}{5}$ trustees; notwithstanding any law to the contrary, 2 of the trustees are alternates, and an alternate may vote only if a quorum has not yet been reached. Trustees must be residents and voters of the district.
7	Sec. 2. P&SL 2009, c. 32, §5-A is enacted to read:
8 9 10 11	Sec. 5-A. Trustees; alternates. The 2 trustees of the district next elected pursuant to section 5 after the effective date of this section are alternate members who may vote only if a quorum has not yet been reached, and the trustees subsequently elected to those positions are alternates.
12	SUMMARY
13 14 15	This bill increases the number of trustees of the Lincolnville Sewer District from 3 to 5. Two of the new members are alternates who may vote only if a quorum has not yet been reached.
