**JOINT RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE CUMBERLAND  
HISTORICAL SOCIETY ON THE GRAND OPENING OF ITS  
RESTORED HEADQUARTERS**

**WHEREAS**, the Cumberland Historical Society has restored its headquarters building;

**WHEREAS**, constructed as a brick schoolhouse in 1853, the building served as an elementary school for nearly 100 years before it became the town hall and police station; and

**WHEREAS**, the Cumberland Historical Society took occupancy of the building in 1989 and the building was moved to the library grounds in 2020, where it underwent a total renovation; and

**WHEREAS**, the headquarters now provides a beautiful space for welcoming visitors and displaying the Town of Cumberland's rich history; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED:** That We, the Members of the One Hundred and Thirty-first Legislature now assembled in the First Special Session, on behalf of the people we represent, take this opportunity to congratulate the Cumberland Historical Society on the grand opening of its restored headquarters.
