This amendment adds the requirement that the price of office equipment for private sale to state employees is the same as the price for public sale. It adds the provision that employees who purchase office equipment accept the equipment in "as is" condition. It clarifies the definition of "office equipment," makes it applicable only to this provision and permits the Department of Administrative and Financial Services to further define the term through rulemaking.

This amendment also changes allocation of a paragraph to reflect the changes made by the amendment.
