4 5 6	The Secretary of State shall attend and complete annually a course of in-person education and training regarding harassment, including, but not limited to, sexual harassment and racial harassment.
7	Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §158 is enacted to read:
8	§158. Required training regarding harassment
9 10 11	The Treasurer of State shall attend and complete annually a course of in-person education and training regarding harassment, including, but not limited to, sexual harassment and racial harassment.
12	Sec. 3. 5 MRSA §191, sub-§5 is enacted to read:
13 14 15	5. Required training regarding harassment. The Attorney General shall attend and complete annually a course of in-person education and training regarding harassment, including, but not limited to, sexual harassment and racial harassment.
