COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 1446, L.D. 1935, “Resolve, Regarding Legislative Review of Portions of Chapter 60: New School Siting Approval, Portions of Chapter 61: State Board of Education Rules for Major Capital School Construction Projects and Portions of Chapter 125: Basic School Approval Standards: Public Schools and School Administrative Units, Major Substantive Rules of the Department of Education, State Board of Education”

Amend the resolve by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'Resolve, Regarding Legislative Review of Portions of Chapter 60: New School Siting Approval, Portions of Chapter 61: State Board of Education Rules for Major Capital School Construction Projects and Portions of Chapter 125: Basic School Approval Standards: Public Schools and School Administrative Units, Major Substantive Rules of the Department of Education and State Board of Education'

Amend the resolve by striking out all of section 1 and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. Adoption. Resolved: That, because the Department of Education and State Board of Education did not hold a public hearing as required pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 8052, subsection 1, final adoption of portions of Chapter 60: New School Siting Approval, portions of Chapter 61: State Board of Education Rules for Major Capital School Construction Projects and portions of Chapter 125: Basic School Approval Standards: Public Schools and School Administrative Units, provisionally adopted major substantive rules of the Department of Education and State Board of Education that have been submitted to the Legislature for review pursuant to Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A, is not authorized.'

Amend the resolve by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, does not authorize final adoption of the major substantive rules because the Department of Education and State
