1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. Authority to lease.** Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title  
3 20-A, section 4103, subsection 2, the board of directors of School Administrative District  
4 No. 6 may lease the former administrative building located at 94 Main Street in Buxton to  
5 the Buxton-Hollis Historical Society for a term of not more than 20 years.

6 **SUMMARY**

7 This bill authorizes the board of directors of School Administrative District No. 6 to  
8 lease a former administrative building to a historical society for a term of not more than 20  
9 years.
