Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, a portion of the boundary line between Waldo County and Knox County in Penobscot Bay 3 4 is as described: 5 1. Beginning at a point located at N 44° 12' 36" and W 68° 53' 48" in a southwesterly direction to N 44° 10' and W 68° 55'; 6 7 2. Beginning at a point located at N 44° 10' and W 68° 55' in a westerly direction to N 44° 10' and W 69° 0'; and 8 9 3. Beginning at a point located at N 44° 10' and W 69° 0' in a northwesterly direction 10 to a point located at N 44° 14' 57" and W 69° 1' 41". **SUMMARY** 11 12 This bill clarifies and describes a portion of the common boundary between Waldo 13 County and Knox County in Penobscot Bay in order to address a discrepancy between
- 14 recent maps and the legislative history of the boundary line.
