1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §3036 is enacted to read:
3	§3036. Pedestrian and bicycle paths
4 5 6	Nothing in this chapter prohibits the municipal officers of an affected municipality from accepting a proposed, unaccepted way as a path exclusively for pedestrian, bicycle and other nonmotorized uses.
7	SUMMARY
8 9	This bill provides that municipal officers may accept a proposed, unaccepted way for pedestrian, bicycle and other nonmotorized uses.
