1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2.	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA 81827, sub-81, as enacted by PL 1997 c. 678 813 is ame

- **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §1827, sub-§1,** as enacted by PL 1997, c. 678, §13, is amended to read:
- 1. Reservation system for overnight camping. The director shall establish a statewide reservation system for overnight camping at state parks with overnight camping facilities that incorporates a deposit system and a mechanism for accepting payments by credit card. Nonresidents may not reserve a campsite during the initial 24-hour period a reservation system is open to the public in a calendar year. Baxter State Park, the Allagash Wilderness Waterway and public reserved and nonreserved lands are excluded from this system.

11 SUMMARY

This bill prohibits nonresidents from reserving a state park campsite during the initial 24-hour period a reservation system is open to the public in a calendar year.
