1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1752, sub-§11, as amended by PL 2011, c. 8, §2, is further amended to read:
4 5 6	<b>11.</b> Low-speed vehicle. A low-speed vehicle registered pursuant to section 501, subsection 11. A low-speed vehicle must be equipped in accordance with section 1925; and
7 8	<b>Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §1752, sub-§12,</b> as enacted by PL 2011, c. 8, §3, is amended to read:
9	12. Antique motorcycle. An antique motorcycle registered under section 457- <u>; and</u>
10	Sec. 3. 29-A MRSA §1752, sub-§13 is enacted to read:
11 12	13. Motor vehicle less than 20 years old. A motor vehicle less than 20 years from the date it was manufactured.
13	SUMMARY
14	This bill exempts a motor vehicle that is less than 20 years old from inspection.
