An Act to Prohibit Government Contracting Organizations from Influencing Elections

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1812-H is enacted to read:
3	<u>§1812-H. Prohibition on political activities</u>
4 5 6 7 8 9 10	A contract with the State in an amount over $500,000$ must include a clause that prohibits the other contracting party, including a person, corporation, union or nonprofit corporation, from engaging in any effort to influence an election in the State through a contribution to a candidate, a political action committee, a political party or a political organization registered as a tax-exempt organization under 26 United States Code, Section 501(c)(4). The period of the prohibition under this section must be for the duration of the contract plus 2 years.
11	SUMMARY
12 13 14 15 16	This bill requires that every contract with the State in an amount over $500,000$ have a clause that prohibits the other contracting party from influencing state elections through contributions to a candidate, a political action committee, a political party or a political organization that is a tax-exempt organization under 26 United States Code, Section $501(c)(4)$ for the duration of the contract plus 2 years.
