1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §4553, sub-§8, as amended by PL 2019, c. 464, §1, is further amended by adding after the first blocked paragraph a new blocked paragraph to read:
4 5 6	"Place of public accommodation" does not include a facility, owned and operated by a private entity, that provides emergency shelter to women or temporary residence to women who are in reasonable fear of their safety.
7	SUMMARY
8 9 10	This bill exempts from the definition of "place of public accommodation" in the Maine Human Rights Act privately owned and operated facilities that provide emergency shelter to women or temporary housing for women who are in reasonable fear of their safety.
