COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to S.P. 457, L.D. 1123, “An Act to Create a Presumption That a Cardiovascular Injury or Disease or Pulmonary Disease Suffered by Certain Law Enforcement Officers Is in the Course of Employment”

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Create a Presumption Under the Maine Workers' Compensation Act of 1992 That a Cardiovascular Injury or Disease or Pulmonary Disease Suffered by Certain Law Enforcement Officers Is in the Course of Employment'

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1.

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment removes from the bill the rebuttable presumption of disability under the Maine Public Employees Retirement System for a law enforcement officer who suffers a disability as a result of a cardiovascular injury or a cardiovascular or pulmonary disease.
