1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§5-B is enacted to read:
3 4 5 6	5-B. Certain prescribed medical supplies. Beginning January 1, 2024, sales of medical equipment and supplies sold pursuant to a prescription by a health care practitioner as defined in Title 24, section 2502, subsection 1-A who is licensed under Title 32 when payment is made by an insurance company, a municipal or state agency or a federally
7 8	funded program such as Medicare or Medicaid.  SUMMARY
9 10 11	This bill provides a sales tax exemption for medical equipment and supplies prescribed by a health care provider for medical purposes when payment is made by an insurance company or specified government programs.
