The amendment removes the provisions under the offense of violation of condition of release that increase the offense from a Class E crime to a Class C crime when the underlying crime is punishable by a maximum period of imprisonment of one year or more and the condition of release violated is a requirement to enter into and remain in a long-term residential facility for the treatment of substance used disorder or a requirement to return to custody for specified hours following release for employment, schooling or other limited purposes.
