COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to S.P. 617, L.D. 1781, “An Act To Align Postpartum MaineCare Coverage with Federal Law”

Amend the bill in section 2 in paragraph A-1 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 10 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "2022" the following: 'and for as long as coverage is allowable by federal law'

Amend the bill in section 6 in paragraph G-1 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 27 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "States" the following: 'for as long as and'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment allows postpartum MaineCare coverage for qualified women as long as federal law allows for it. New federal options for 12 months of postpartum coverage are currently set to expire on April 1, 2027.
