An Act To Allow Bars with an Occupancy of 30 or Fewer Persons To Have Only One Bathroom

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 10 MRSA §9726 is enacted to read:
3	§9726. Requirements for on-premises retail licensees
4 5 6 7 8 9 10	 Toilet facility requirements. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, premises operated by an on-premises retail licensee that has an occupancy of 30 or fewer persons must have at least one toilet facility. A municipal building code may not require premises operated by an on-premises retail licensee that has an occupancy of 30 or fewer persons to have more than one toilet facility. For purposes of this subsection, "on-premises retail licensee" has the same meaning as in Title 28-A, section 2, subsection 27, paragraph B. Rules. The board may adopt rules to implement this section. Rules adopted
12 13	pursuant to this subsection are routine technical rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.
14	SUMMARY
15 16 17	This bill prohibits municipal building codes or other law from requiring an establishment that permits on-premises consumption of alcoholic beverages that has an occupancy of 30 or fewer persons to have more than one toilet facility.
