The amendment removes the 8 ability of an employee in the Department of Health and Human Services who has responsibility for providing direct care to persons in need of mental health services in a 9 10 community-based or residential setting or to residents or patients of mental health institutions in the State to elect to participate in the 1998 Special Plan of the Maine Public 11 Employees Retirement System. The United States Internal Revenue Service does not 12 13 permit such elections by employees in a qualified plan.
