COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to S.P. 788, L.D. 1939, “An Act to Amend the Membership of the Maine-Canadian Legislative Advisory Commission and the New England and Eastern Canada Legislative Commission”

Amend the bill in section 1 in §227 in the first indented paragraph in the 10th line (page 1, line 25 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "The" the following: 'legislative'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §227 in the first indented paragraph in the 10th line (page 1, line 25 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "appointed" the following: 'by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House must appoint legislative members to the Maine-Canadian Legislative Advisory Commission equally from the 2 parties holding the largest number of seats in the Legislature.
