1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §2601, sub-§8-A, as enacted by PL 1997, c. 45, §1, is repealed.
3	Sec. 2. 22 MRSA §2604-A, as enacted by PL 1997, c. 45, §2, is repealed.
4	SUMMARY
5 6 7	This bill repeals the definition of "roadside spring" in the law governing water for human consumption and the provision exempting certain roadside springs from regulation as public water systems.
