Statement of Fact

This financial order allots a portion of the anticipated unencumbered balance forward to fund one limited-period IF&W Resource Biologist position that will collaborate with regional wildlife biologists, the deer biologist, and land acquisition staff to prioritize deer habitat for potential acquisition by the Department, coordinate the management of department-owned wintering areas and associated summer habitat and provide technical assistance to private land owners on the management of deer wintering areas. Failure to approve this financial order will have a detrimental impact on the department's ability to effectively coordinate and manage the state's deer habitat. This position will start on July 1, 2023 and end on June 30, 2025.
