Some of the strategic priorities are to prevent the early use of addictive substances by children, youth, and young adults; to reduce the number of prescribed and illicitly obtained opioids; to reduce the number of fatal and non-fatal overdoses; to support individuals in recovery and to engage active users. Failure to allot these funds would cause several Substance Use Disorder programs to end. Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 20010 allows funds to be collected through fees derived from manufacturers that sell, deliver, or distribute opioid medications.
