This instrument will increase the unit's ability to detect new and emerging novel opioids and allow for early detection of new drugs in Maine. This piece of equipment is split funded between federal funds from the Overdose Data to Action (OD2A) grant award and General Funds. Funds are no longer required in the All Other line category for the purpose originally intended due to a reduction in anticipated supplies expenditures.
