This financial order increases allotment in the Multimodal-Transit account Personal Services line category and decreases allotment in the Capital Expenditures line category to fund a payroll shortage caused by departmental personnel being utilized in areas other than their budgeted appropriation. Funds are not required in the current fiscal year in the Capital Expenditures line category for the purpose for which they were originally intended due to delays in vehicles purchases.
