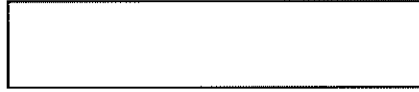

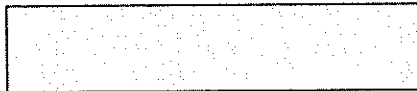

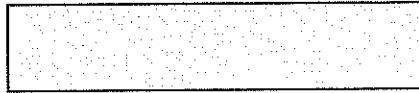

The PSM III position is responsible for the comprehensive coordination and alignment of policies, programs and initiatives related to the revisioning of the education system, technology and digital integration. The PSC I position is responsible for performing fiscal monitoring and providing training and technical assistance to local educational agencies. Funds are no longer required in the All Other line category for the purpose for which they were originally intended due to a reallocation of resources to fund these positions. Failure to allot these funds will result in delays in continuing the RREV program.

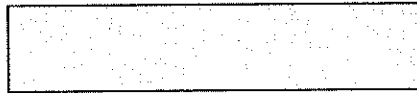

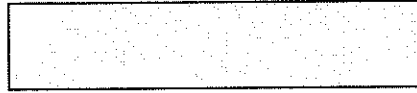

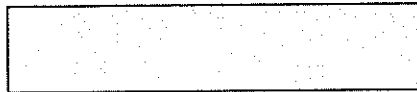

Specifically, Maine CDC will assist with the following tasks: establishing public health oversight of PFAS blood serum testing and developing public health education resources; conducting a farmer and farm worker soil exposure study; evaluating medical interventions to accelerate the removal of PFAS from exposed humans; analyzing laboratory data and methodologies; creating communication materials; and undertaking investigations of PFAS-contaminated sites to guide future work. Failure to allot these funds would result in the terms of the MOU going unmet.
