The Center for Outdoor Education is being established on Mackworth Island in Falmouth, Maine. Mackworth Island is an ideal site for summer coastal ecology programs, providing outdoor access to trails, playing fields, forests, beaches, Casco Bay and adjacent indoor access to a large gym. The project will benefit multiple schools and community-based outdoor education agencies serving Maine students by providing hands-on marine science education and extended learning opportunities. Construction funds are needed for an outdoor pavilion to provide a shaded outdoor activity area and learning center. This project was awarded through the Maine Outdoor Learning Initiative and funded by the ARP Governor's Emergency Education Relief Fund. The Department of Education was awarded an American Rescue Plan - Emergency Assistance to Non-Public Schools (ARP EANS) grant (ALN# 84.425V) through the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 Education Stabilization Fund.
