For most issues you can simply call our office at 287-HELP (4357). This phone is forwarded to Building Control when no one is in our office. Building Control is manned 24/7.

The emergency number 287-6911 will ring directly into our dispatch (Building Control) and is set as the priority phone to answer in that room. The dispatcher can immediately contact CP Officers via radio. People in the State House can, obviously, call 911; but, those calls will be routed to the Regional Communication Center, then to Augusta City PD, and then to Building Control. Calling 287-6911 on any phone will get you directly to our dispatch, Building Control.

*There is usually always a Capitol Police officer assigned to the Security Kiosk while the State House is open to the public. This number can be used for questions or routine matters, but be aware that the officer is not always at the desk and is not available to respond outside the screening area.
