Statutes

Statutes are the written laws enacted by the Legislature. They address many subjects. You can search or browse Maine's statutes <u>online</u>. <u>Contact the Law Library</u> if you're having trouble finding a law on your topic.

Court Rules

Court rules explain in detail the procedures you must follow for your case to be considered by the Courts. <u>Maine's court rules are available</u> <u>online</u>. <u>Contact the Law Library</u> for resources that can help you understand them.
