# Statement of Fact

This financial order allots the entire unencumbered balance forward in the All Other category of \$3,593 to pay the funds to the Passamaquoddy Tribe for municipal services to unorganized territory (UT) taxpayers in Indian Township who are not members of the Tribe. These funds are authorized by the legislature, who annually enact the municipal cost component legislation to fund governmental services. The payment is based on a calculation that Maine Revenue Services performs annually after the property tax bills for the UT are completed on August 1 of each year. Indian Township is in the UT of Washington County, and Maine Revenue Services applies the Washington County UT tax rate against the valuation of Indian Township to arrive at the amount owed to the Tribe by non-tribal UT taxpayers. The 2017 payment to the Tribe increased because the 2017 UT tax rate in Washington County increased to \$6.25 from the 2016 tax rate of \$5.01. This caused a higher payment than the amount anticipated. Payment is statutorily due before October 31, 2017. Failure to approve this financial order will have a detrimental impact on the municipal services provided to the UT residents in Indian Township.
