Statement of Fact

This financial order revises allotment in the County Tax Reimbursement account by reducing allotment in the fourth quarter and increasing allotment in the second and third quarters in the All Other line category. Maine Revenue Services collects excise taxes for the counties and makes reimbursement payments to the counties on a quarterly basis. This financial order will provide sufficient allotment to meet the projected payments in the second and third quarters. Based on current projections, there are not sufficient funds in this account to meet the obligations of the program for the balance of the fiscal year. The department will submit another financial order later in fiscal year 2017-18 to increase fourth quarter allotment when revenue projections and expenses can be more accurately determined. Failure to approve this financial order will result in the inability to provide tax reimbursement payments to the counties.

Statement of Fact

This allotment will be used to cover the cost of the Public Utilities Commission's remaining monthly payments to Emera Maine for their contractual above-market costs during the second and third quarter of fiscal year 2017-18. The need for additional allotment is based on increases in actual payments to Emera Maine, as compared to the original projections. Public Law 2015, chapter 483, sub-§1-6B directs the Public Utilities Commission to pay above-market costs associated with biomass contracts established under this Public Law from the Cost Recovery Fund. This section directs investor-owned transmission and distribution utilities (Emera and Central Maine Power) to enter into one or more 2-year contracts for biomass resources. Failure to approve this order will prevent the Commission from being in compliance with the requirements of the above referenced statute.

Statement of Fact

The Maine Public Utilities Commission has received a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) for a 1200MW transmission line, Docket 2017-00232. A filing fee covering the Commission's costs in its review of the CPCN will be received by the Commission from the utility proposing the CPCN. Pursuant to Maine Statute, in determining the public need for a CPCN, the Commission shall take into account the costs and benefits of the proposed transmission line, system reliability, and other matters. The Commission will contract for expert consulting services to assist in the review of the CPCN. The Commission estimates the consulting services to be approximately \$200,000. This \$200,000 allotment will be used to encumber the consulting contract.

Failure to approve this financial order will have a detrimental impact on the program, as the result will be the inability to provide sufficient analysis and review of the CPCN, thus potentially causing adverse consequences in terms of cost and reliability for Maine consumers.
