The position will be funded through August 31, 2019 with a transfer from the All Other line category to the Personal Services line category. Funds are no longer required in All Other for the purpose for which they were originally intended due to one-time savings derived from a reduction in contracted services. A budget initiative will be included in the biennial budget to continue the position permanently by using a vacant position.

The Maine Municipal Bond Bank provides the oversight of the match funds. Failure to allot these funds will not allow the match to be met and federal funds will be forfeited.

Statement of Fact

This financial order allots a portion of the unencumbered balance forward to provide funding for harbor planning and design projects in the Shore and Harbor Management Program and the personal service needs to finish up the Abandoned & Derelict Vessel (ADVs) Prevention Program. Funding for the Shore and Harbor Management Program assists municipalities in developing harbor management, mooring, infrastructure plans and designs in addition to providing an opportunity for a town to plan for new or rediscover public access. Additionally, the Coastal Program is researching tools and policies to prevent ADVs from occurring in Maine's waters. Floating and submerged ADVs can become collision hazards in navigation areas, and if left unresolved can leak pollutants like fuel and oil, potentially damaging the local community, marine life, and nearby habitat. Revenue for these purposes is derived from transfers from the Shore and Harbor Management Fund and the Submerged Lands Fund. Failure to allot these funds will have a detrimental impact on the programs' ability to improve on our shores and harbors and will not allow prevention measures to be assessed and to prevent ADVs from occurring.
