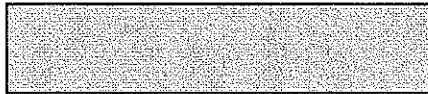

Statement of Fact

This financial order allots a portion of the unencumbered balance forward in the County Tax Reimbursement account by \$123,744 in the All Other line category. Maine Revenue Services collects excise taxes for the counties and makes reimbursement payments to the counties on a quarterly basis. This financial order will provide sufficient allotment to meet the projected payments in the third quarter. Failure to approve this financial order will result in the inability to provide tax reimbursement payments to the counties.

Statement of Fact

This financial order will enable the Department to transfer funding from the Department of Corrections account that would end the year with a surplus to Mountain View Correctional Facility that would end the year with a deficit and enable the Department to close out the year with a zero balance in both programs. The Department of Corrections is running a surplus in All Other in the program due to the establishment of program targets under baseline funding levels. The department has met with the program manager and confirmed that funds are no longer required in the Department of Corrections All Other line category for the purpose for which they were originally intended due to the establishment of program targets and is available for use by Mountain View Correctional Facility.





Statement of Fact

This financial order provides funds for conservation treatment and document imaging needed to preserve 23 manuscript maps. These maps range in date from 1812 to 1836. Based on the poor condition of these maps, preservation methods must be taken to prevent them from being destroyed. These maps are historical in nature and will be used for the 2020 State of Maine bicentennial. A portion of the unencumbered balance forward is needed for these costs. Failure to allot these funds will prevent these historical maps from being preserved for future generations.
