The E-911 surcharge fee is then transferred by the PUC to the Emergency Services Communications account, and the USF and TEAF are then remitted to an independent fiscal agent who administers the funds. Due to an increase to the USF and TEAF Prepaid Wireless Fee per PUC Docket No. 2016-00228, the PUC requires this additional authorization for the increase in allotment for payments to the independent fiscal agent and decrease in transfers out to the Emergency Services Communication account. Failure to approve this order will prevent the PUC from being in compliance with the requirements of the above referenced statute.
