Statement of Fact

This financial order provides allotment in the Capital Expenditures line category through a transfer from the All Other line category to purchase a Tuttnauer autoclave. The Tuttnauer autoclave will be used in the analysis of environmental water quality and COVID-19 testing for the Health and Environmental Testing Laboratory (HETL) within the Department of Health and Human Services. This instrument is required to conduct the analytical methods used for determining phosphorous levels in the State of Maine's lakes and streams. Due to the loss of a required autoclave, HETL will not have the capability of conducting phosphorous analysis for environmental water monitoring clients. This autoclave will provide additional capacity to sterilize saline for the use in the COVID-19 collection kits, and as expanded testing occurs more saline will be required for the additional tests. Funds are no longer required in the All Other line category for the purpose for which they were originally intended due to savings in General Operations.
