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That the State Controller increase allotment in account 014-13A-0027-16, Halibut Fund by \$12,031 in the All Other line category for the purpose of allotting a portion of the anticipated unencumbered balance forward for implantable electronic data storage tags and contracted vessel services for the halibut longline survey; and,

Be it further ordered, that the State Controller authorize the expenditure in accordance with the attached "Revision of the Work Program for Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2021", for which this shall be our sufficient warrant.

## Statement of Fact

This financial order allots a portion of the anticipated unencumbered balance forward for implantable electronic data storage tags and contracted vessel services for the halibut longline survey. The purpose of this survey is to provide an index of adult halibut biomass as a basis for future assessments. The DST centi-ex archival tags will be surgically implanted into live Atlantic halibut. These tags collect data on temperature and depth at pre-programmed time intervals and can take measurements at depths up to 5,000 feet. The data from these tags can be used to determine where halibut migrate and if, when and where they spawn. Failure to allot these funds will cause a detrimental impact on the ability to continue to set precautionarily low catch limits. This could result in lost revenue in our state waters halibut fishery and the broader federally-managed multispecies fishery.
