Resolved: That the Department of Health and Human Services 2 shall amend its rule Chapter 101: MaineCare Benefits Manual, Chapter III, Section 45.03 3 to provide reimbursement for patients discharged from Southern Maine Health Care's 4 psychiatric inpatient unit in the amount of \$13,396.47 per distinct discharge. The 5 department shall amend its rule pursuant to this section in time to be submitted to the 6 United States Department of Health and Human Services, Centers for Medicare and 7 Medicaid Services with an effective date of the reimbursement required by this section of 8 July 1, 2020. 9

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#### SUMMARY
