Like the majority report, the amendment provides ongoing appropriations totaling \$2,035,670 from the General Fund to be distributed by the Department of Health and Human Services to a single grantee to provide management and oversight of the delivery of family planning services. The amendment also provides one-time funds of \$1,017,835 to the former recipient of federal Title X funds for the State for the period from January 1, 2020 to June 30, 2020. This amendment differs from the majority report in that it includes language to prohibit the Department of Health and Human Services from selecting a provider to provide management and oversight of family planning services if that provider provides, promotes, refers for or supports abortion as a method of family planning.
