- Cooperate with other agencies in the state interested in improving public education



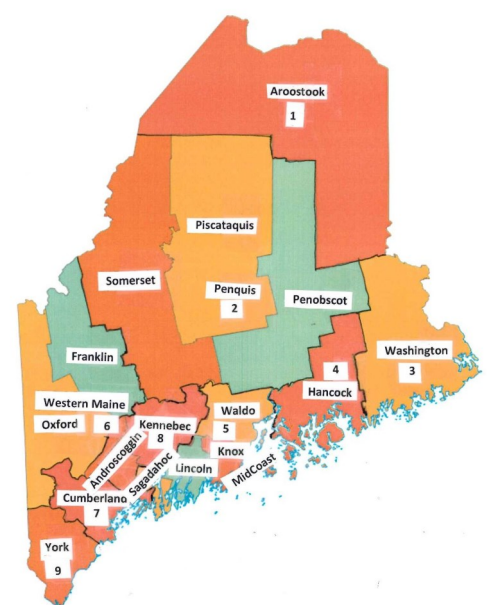
We See the Big Picture
