

# **INTELLIGENCE AND INVESTIGATIVE RECORD INFORMATION (IIRI)**

**“Intelligence and investigative record information’ means information of record collected by or prepared by or at the direction of a criminal justice agency or kept in the custody of a criminal justice agency while performing the administration of criminal justice or, exclusively for the Department of the Attorney General and district attorneys’ offices, the administration of civil justice. ‘Intelligence and investigative record information’ includes information of record concerning investigative techniques and procedures and security plans and procedures prepared or collected by a criminal justice agency or other agency. ‘Intelligence and investigative record information’ does not include criminal history record information as defined in section 703, subsection 3 and does not include information of record collected or kept while performing the administration of juvenile justice.” 16 M.R.S. § 803(7).**

## **EXAMPLES OF IIRI:**

- **Copies of personal diary information, personal notes, and personal correspondence**
- **Copies of downloaded data from personal smart phones and personal computer hard drives**
- **Copies of personal social media pages**
- **Copies of personal emails and text messages**
- **Copies of personal medical records and information**
- **Copies of personal audio and video recordings**
- **Photographs, including of decedents, victims, and suspects**
- **Copies of Medical Examiner reports**
- **Written or video- or audio-recorded statements of victims, suspects, and witnesses**
- **Personal DNA information**
- **Law enforcement-only database inquiry results (as examples, CHRI queries that would include confidential CHRI, driver history inquiries, warrant inquiries)**
- **Written investigation-related reports**
- **Investigation-related reports and materials of other law enforcement agencies**
- **Cruiser camera video recordings**
- **Records that include tactical information**
- **Records disclosing or pertaining to types of security procedures or investigative technologies used by a law enforcement agency**
